• Celebrating Diversity, Inclusion & Reflection

Dear Parents,

This month, the Counseling Department focused on Diversity and Inclusion, creating meaningful opportunities for our students to reflect on identity, empathy, and community.

Diversity & Inclusion in Action

Throughout the month, we shared strong morning messages reminding students that:

- Everyone is fighting a battle we may not see.
- Respect grows when we choose our words wisely.
- Small acts of kindness can change someone's entire day.

These messages encouraged our girls to lead with empathy, compassion, and awareness, values that are deeply aligned with the spirit of Ramadan.

Ramadan teaches us patience (sabr), generosity, humility, and mindfulness in our actions and speech. We tied these principles into our discussions, helping students understand that inclusion begins with intentional kindness, especially in moments when it is easier to judge than to understand.





“I Am More Than...” Activity

Students participated in a reflective activity titled “I Am More Than...” This activity encouraged them to look beyond labels. For example:

- “People may see me as Head Girl, but I am also a gamer.”
- “People may see me as quiet, but I am creative.”
- “People may see me as athletic, but I am also sensitive.”

The goal was to challenge assumptions and remind students that identity is layered and multifaceted. It sparked thoughtful conversations about stereotypes and the importance of seeing others fully.



Get to Know Your Teacher Challenge

In the spirit of inclusion, we extended the initiative to our teachers through a “Get to Know Your Teacher” Challenge.

Students learned about their teachers beyond academics, their hobbies, passions, hidden talents, and personal interests. This activity helped humanize classroom relationships and strengthen connection, reminding students that belonging goes both ways.





The Power of Words Activity

One of the most impactful sessions focused on understanding the impact of words. Through scenarios and guided reflection, students explored:

- How can the same message be delivered respectfully or hurtfully.
- How tone, timing, and intention affect impact.
- How pausing and reframing can transform a potentially harmful comment into a constructive one.
- Students recognized that sometimes harm is not intentional, but impact still matters. They practiced taking a small but powerful step: think, reframe, then speak.

Visual Representation Around School

Our counseling boards were updated to visually reflect themes of diversity, inclusion, empathy, and belonging. These boards serve as daily reminders that:

- Differences are strengths.
- Every student has a place.
- Respect is a shared responsibility.



How Parents Can Reinforce This at Home

You can continue these conversations by:

- Asking your child: “What is something people don’t know about you?”
- Discuss how words can impact others.
- Modeling inclusive language and curiosity instead of assumptions.
- Reflecting together on how Ramadan values can guide everyday interactions.

We are proud of how thoughtfully our students engaged in these discussions. Creating a culture of inclusion is not a one-time lesson; it is an ongoing commitment, and we are grateful for your partnership in reinforcing these values at home.

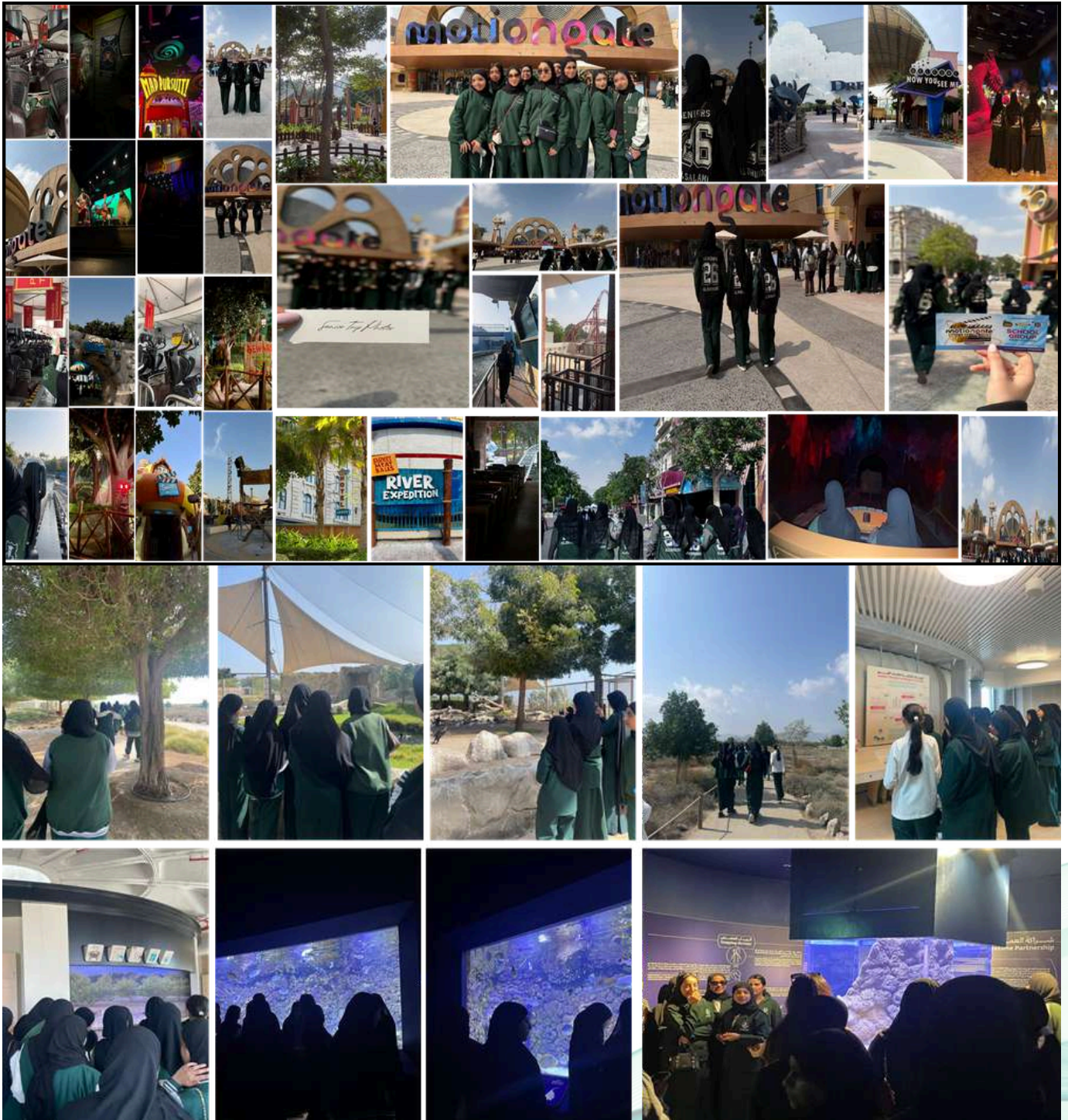




Middle & High School Section

Grade 7 students continue to collaborate for the End of Unit project as they work in groups to write skits with well-developed characters, engaging plots, and realistic dialogue.



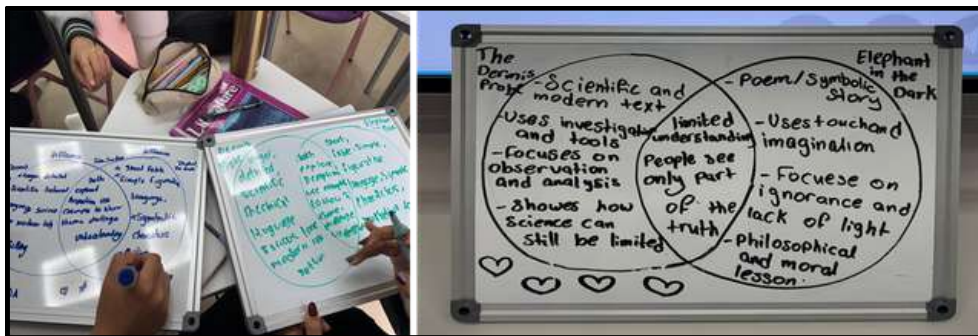


Grade 8A students recently held a Socratic Seminar on the theme of justice, engaging in a thoughtful exchange of ideas as they questioned and responded to one another.

Math: High School

30th January (Friday) – Mental Math Interclass Challenge!

Our high school students demonstrated their mathematical skills in an engaging interclass competition focused on speed, accuracy, and teamwork. Each round included a 3-minute mental math challenge, followed by 5 minutes of collaborative problem-solving.

The group tasks required students to apply concepts in meaningful ways—calculating the volume of paper used in a tissue roll and using GeoGebra to solve linear, quadratic, and exponential functions. The room was filled with focus, smart strategies, and strong collaboration.

The awarding ceremony on 6th February celebrated top performers and appreciated the efforts of all participants. Congratulations to our high school mathematicians for their confidence, teamwork, and excellent progress!



Visualizing, playing, and mastering equations Grade 9 at work!

Grade 9 students actively engaged in hands-on learning through interactive math activities. In one session, students solved systems of equations using the substitution method with the help of algebra tiles, strengthening their conceptual understanding through visual representation.

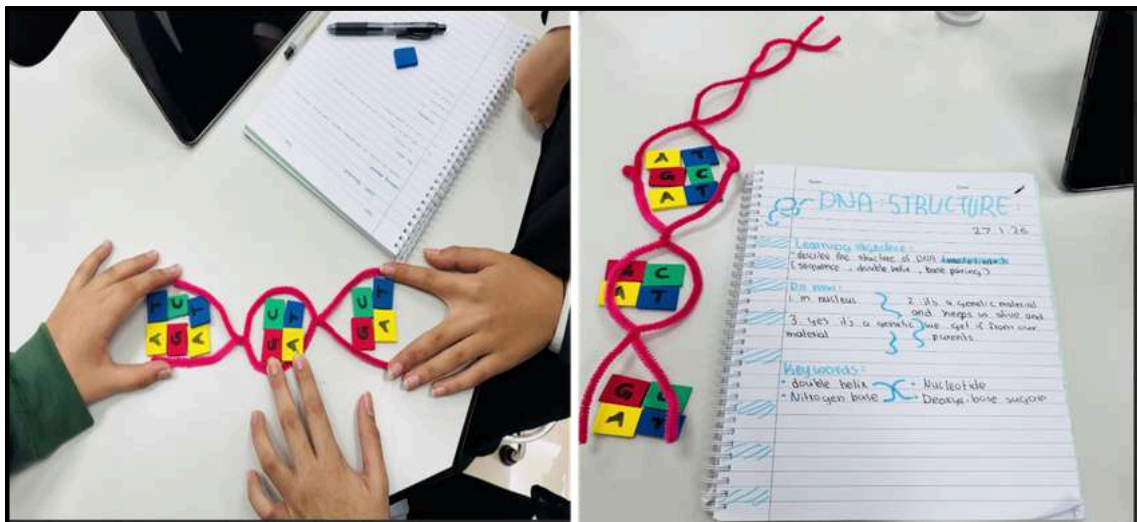

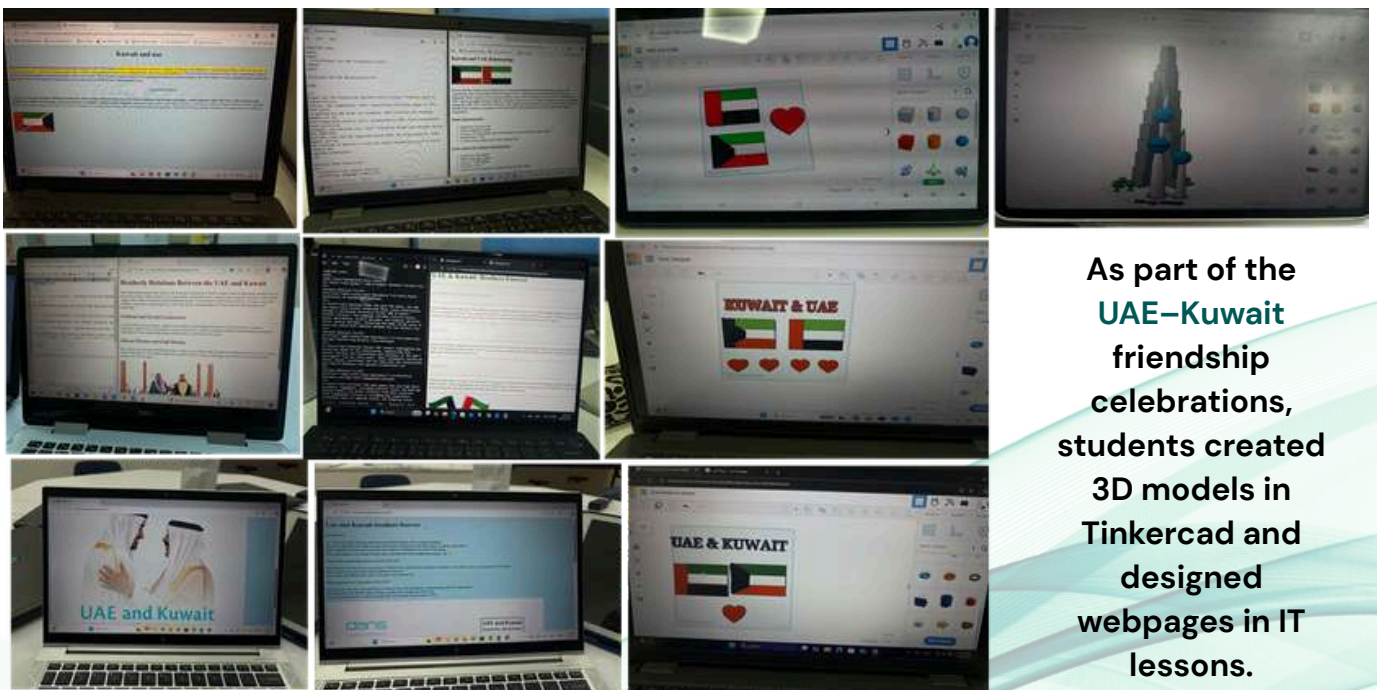


• Global Social Studies

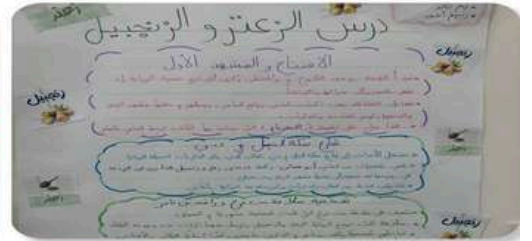

- وإصرارهن على أن يكون لهن دور في بناء عالم أفضل.

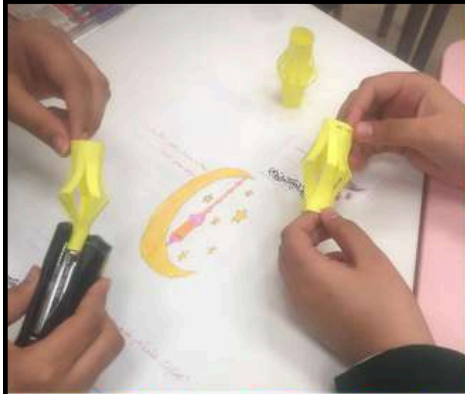
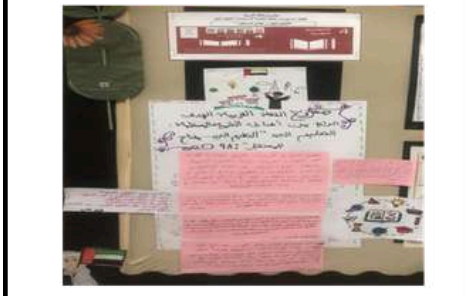
