We look forward to seeing your little ones thrive in their chosen activities!





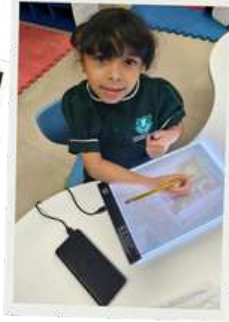

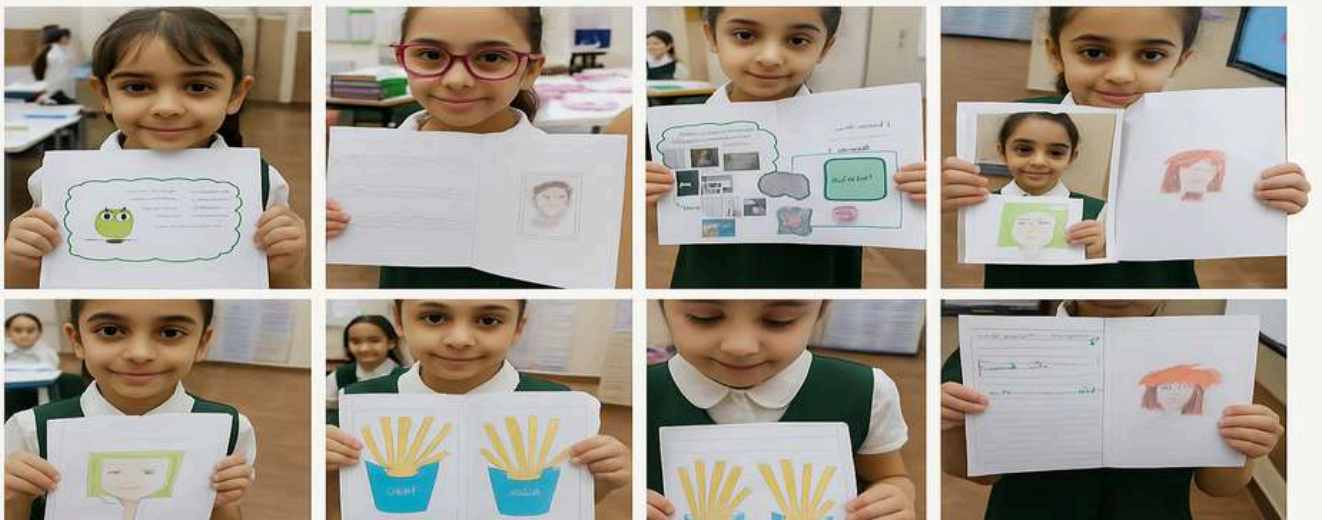

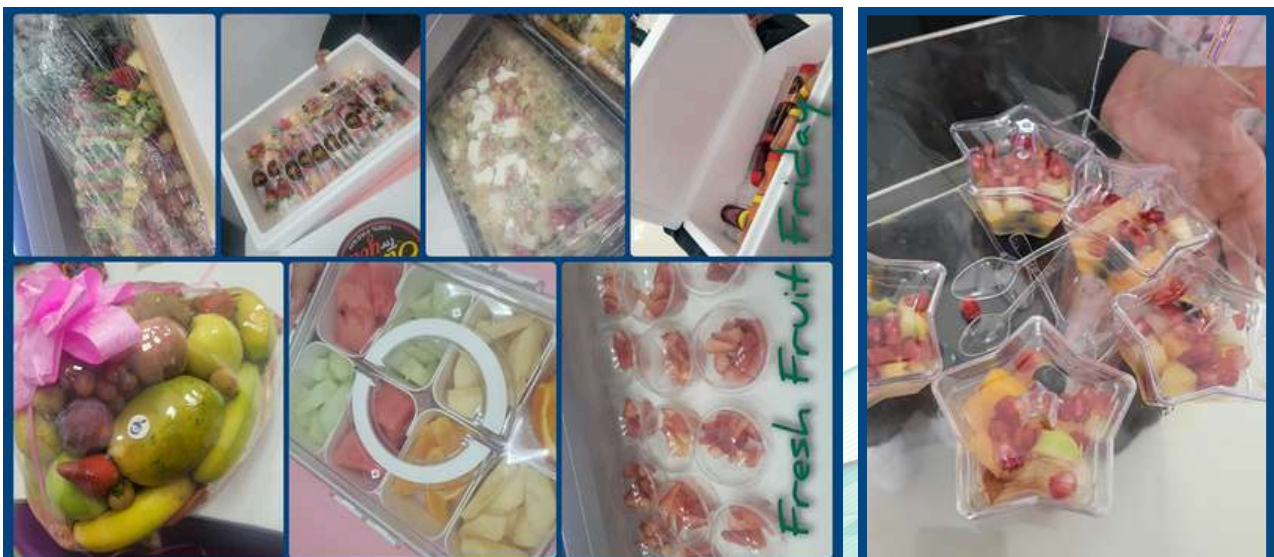
Our senior students have been exploring their futures!

In October we continued promoting healthy habits with our Fresh Fruit Fridays...thank you to all parents for supporting this initiative.





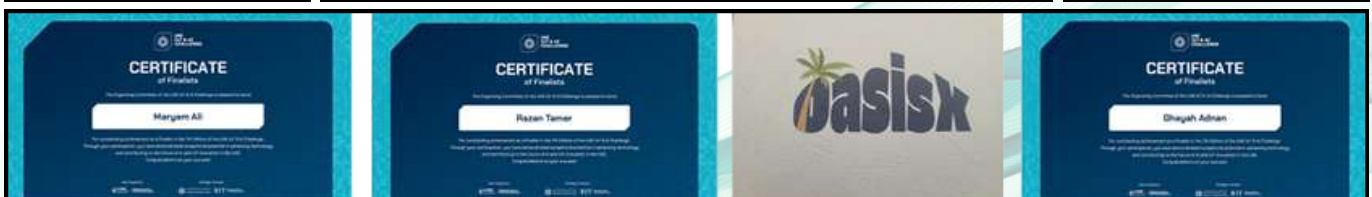
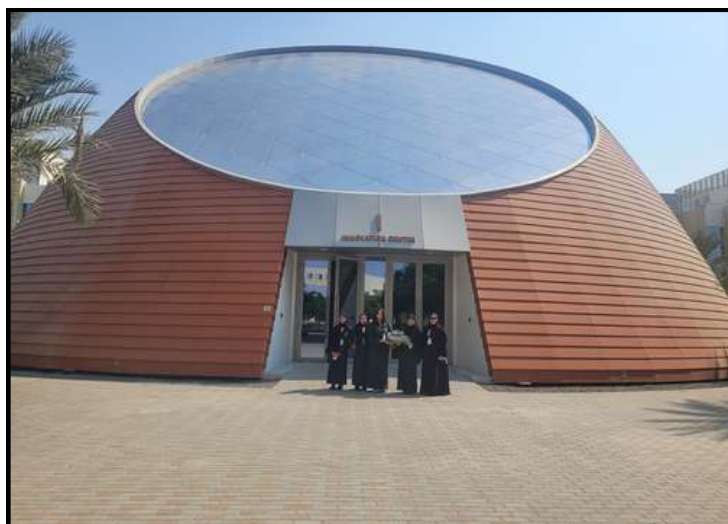
On October 10th we celebrated **PINK DAY** with events across middle and high school including information boards, homeroom activities and art fun event with PTA.

The event followed a “Dragon’s Den” format, challenging students to combine AI and sustainability to design innovative solutions for the future.

Grade 7 English has been analyzing poetry by Edgar Allan Poe and Lewis Carroll in preparation to write their own poems based on their original AI-generated characters. Business:

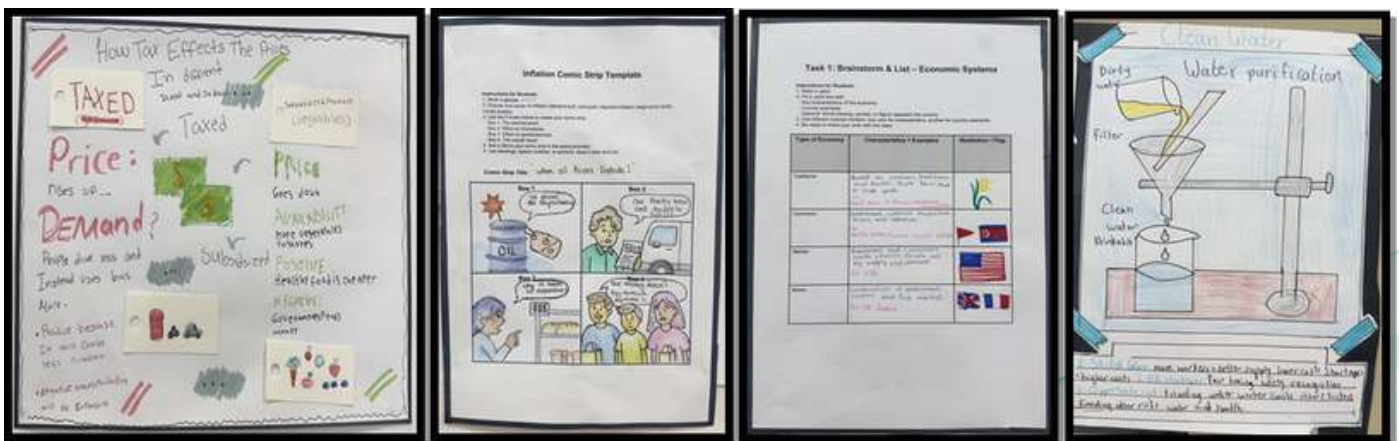
October a month of growth and discovery as our students explore how economics shapes the world around them.

Grade 9 Business Studies: Students examined how government policies like taxes and subsidies influence business activity and promote responsible growth.

Grade 10 Microeconomics: Students explored how employment in business supports sustainable goals such as clean water and sanitation (SDG 6).

Grade 11 Macroeconomics: Students studied inflation and currency values, learning how these affect purchasing power and global trade.

Grade 12 Economics: Students compared different economic systems to understand how nations balance efficiency, equity, and growth.





October Sparks of Innovation in Computer Science:

This month, students across Grades 9–12 explored key programming and problem-solving skills. Grade 9 focused on robotics and sensor-based control, Grade 10 advanced in Python coding and logical thinking, Grade 11 practiced interpreting and analysing data, and Grade 12 strengthened their Java programming foundations. These activities align with the UAE MOE AI Curriculum Phase 4, building students' analytical, coding, and data-driven thinking skills essential for Artificial Intelligence.
