Anti-Bullying Month Highlights

Throughout this month, the Counseling Department led a series of school-wide initiatives dedicated to promoting kindness, understanding, and a culture of respect. Our aim was to raise awareness about the impact of bullying while helping students recognize the important role they play in creating a safe and supportive school community.

To encourage everyday acts of compassion, each class participated in Kindness Bingo, completing simple yet meaningful challenges that strengthened empathy and positive peer connections. In addition, students across the school united in signing our Anti-Bullying Pledge, committing themselves to stand up against unkind behavior and to treat others with dignity and care.



The school was filled with warm messages through our Kindness Charts, where students wrote notes of appreciation to their friends, teachers, and staff members. These displays became a daily reminder that kindness—especially the smallest gesture—can make a significant difference.



Our Wellbeing Champions from middle and high school also took part by visiting the KG section to read anti-bullying themed stories. These moments of shared learning helped younger students understand the importance of kindness while offering older students an opportunity to model leadership and empathy.



We also celebrated Odd Socks Day, a fun and symbolic reminder that our differences make us unique and should be celebrated rather than judged. Additionally, counselors delivered guidance lessons across grade levels focused on recognizing bullying, nurturing empathy, and learning healthy ways to communicate and seek help.

We also held a powerful anti-bullying assembly that brought important lessons to life through student participation and interactive learning. Students opened the program with a meaningful play and presentation highlighting the impact of bullying and the importance of kindness in our community. We also led a hands-on demonstration where students were asked to damage a piece of chart paper and then try to restore it. Despite their efforts, they couldn't make it look whole again—an activity designed to illustrate a crucial message: words can leave lasting scars, and once harm is done, it cannot simply be undone. The assembly served as a strong reminder to think before we speak and to treat one another with empathy and respect.





A major highlight of the month was our middle school Bullying Week Workshops, centered on the theme of kindness and emotional awareness. These sessions encouraged students to reflect on the hidden challenges others may be facing. The core message was simple yet powerful: we rarely know the weight someone else may be carrying, and even those who appear “okay” might be struggling beneath the surface. Students explored how choosing kindness—rather than adding heaviness to someone’s day—can create a ripple effect of support and positivity throughout the school.



Together, these initiatives reflect our school’s ongoing commitment to fostering an environment where every student feels seen, valued, and safe. By engaging learners of all ages in meaningful conversations and activities, we continue to build a community rooted in empathy, respect, and genuine care for one another.

We look forward to more exciting experiences ahead as we continue supporting their learning journey together.



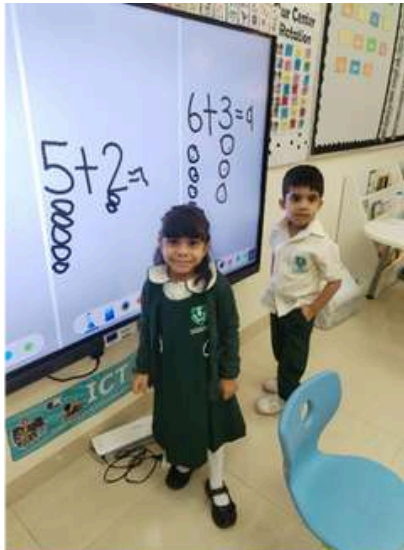

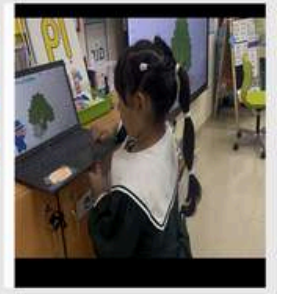

Wishing you all a happy and prosperous New Year.

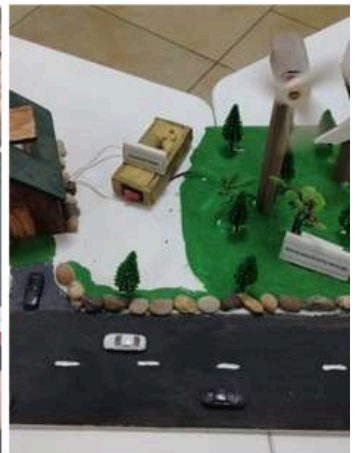

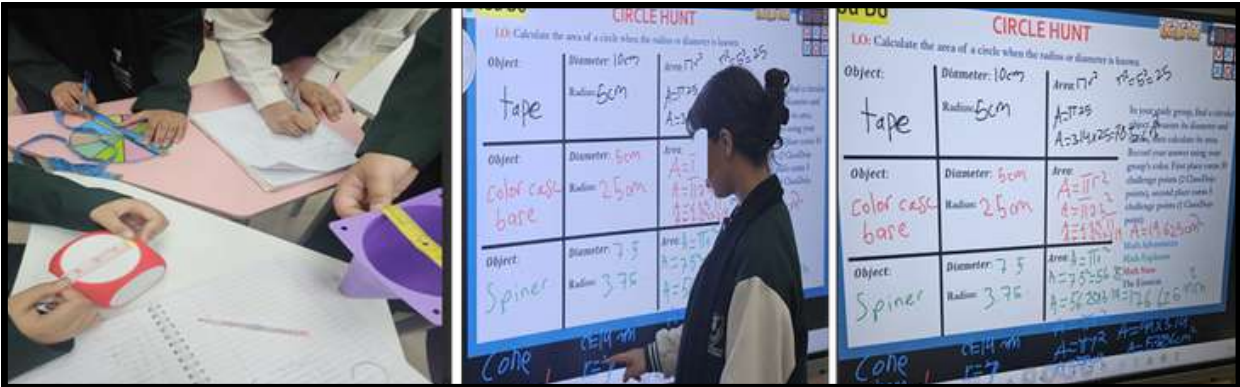


• Math – Middle School

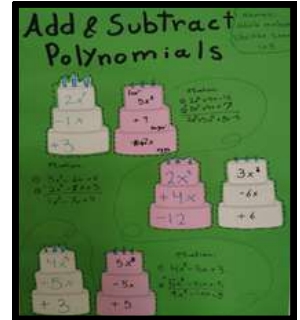
Peer Teaching Spotlight: Grade 10 Shares Their Skills with Grade 9

Science National Day Activities Celebration

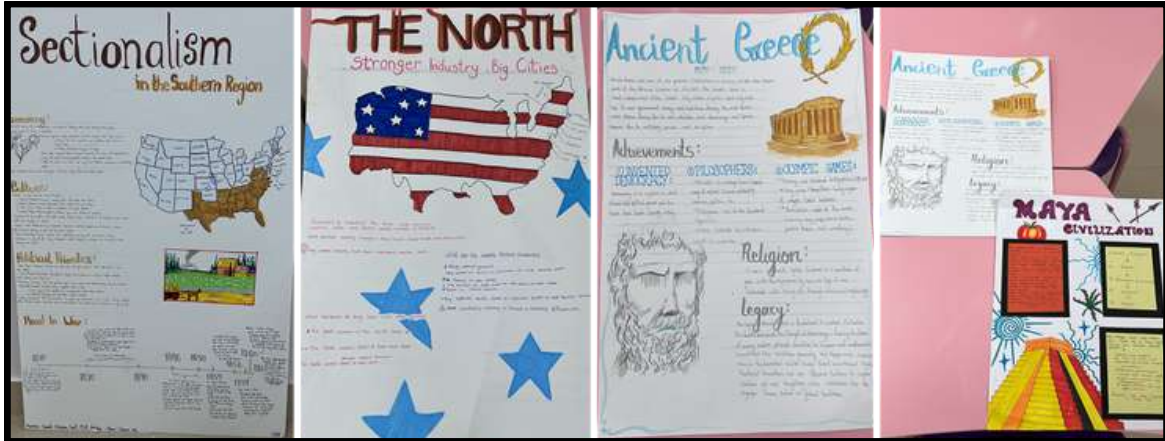

- Grade 8 (IMYC – Community Unit) worked on a community-themed canvas project and completed it beautifully.

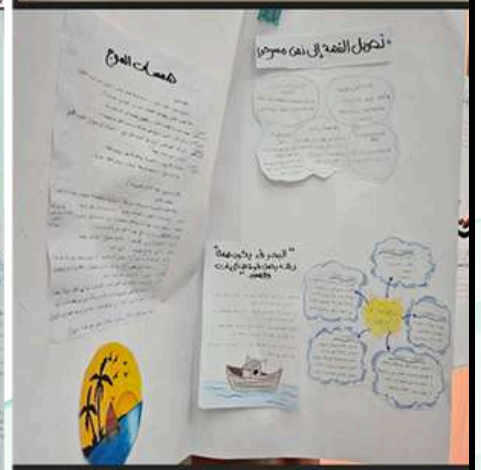
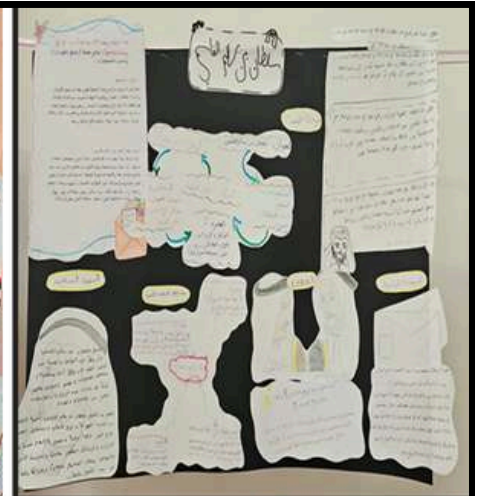

والتفاعل داخل الصف.



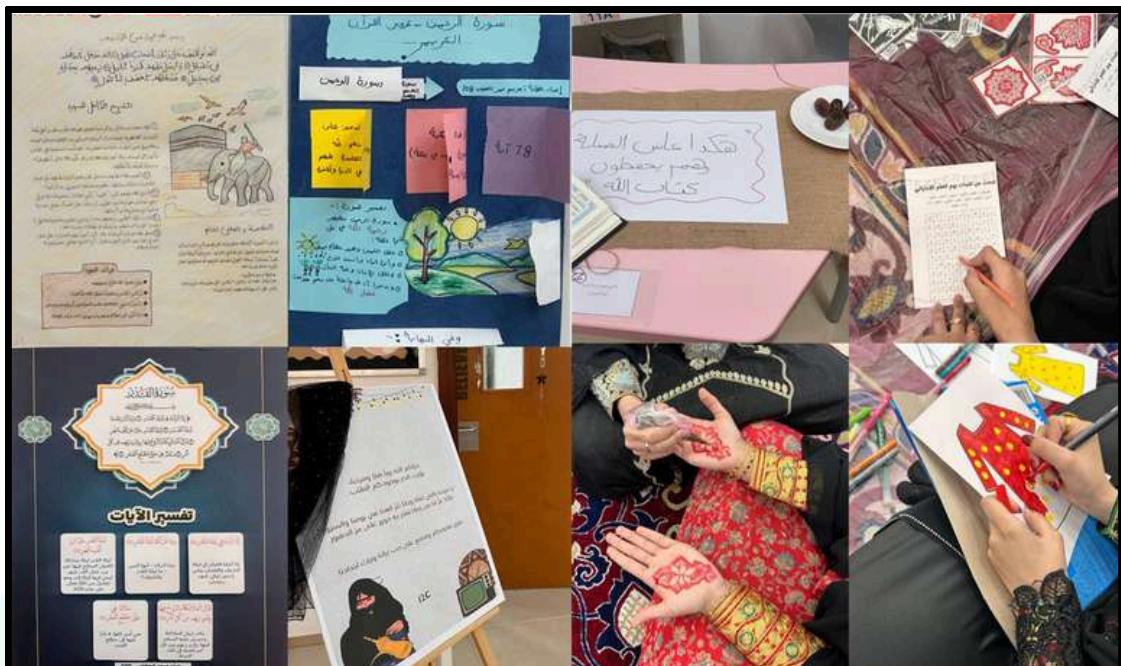

مشروع مدرستي الخضراء:

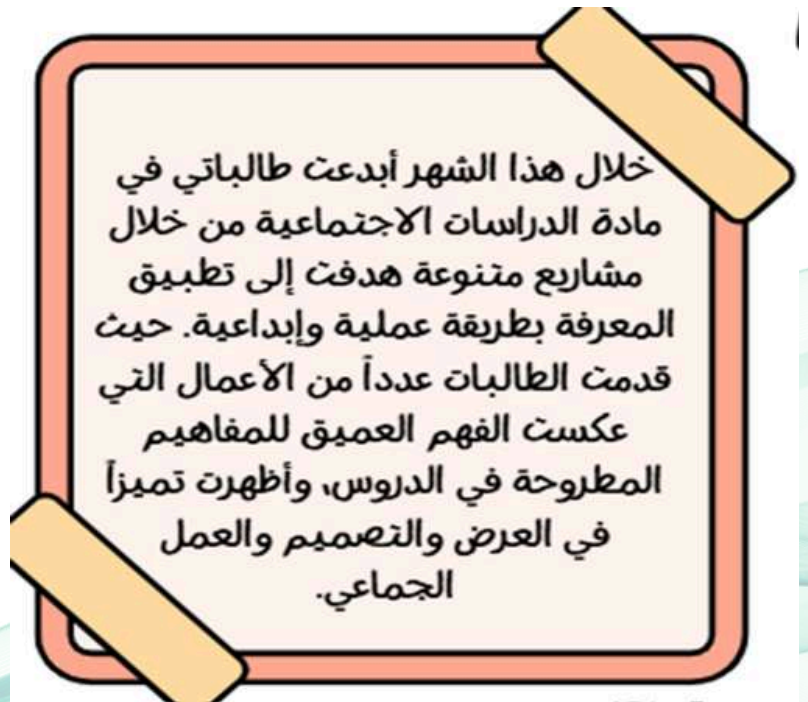
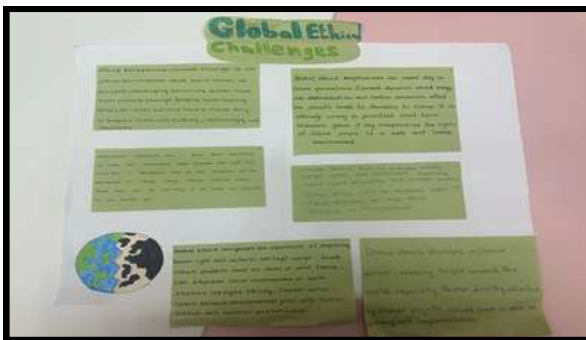
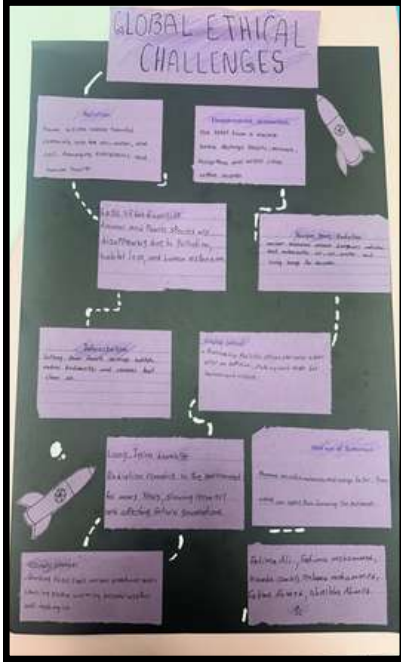
